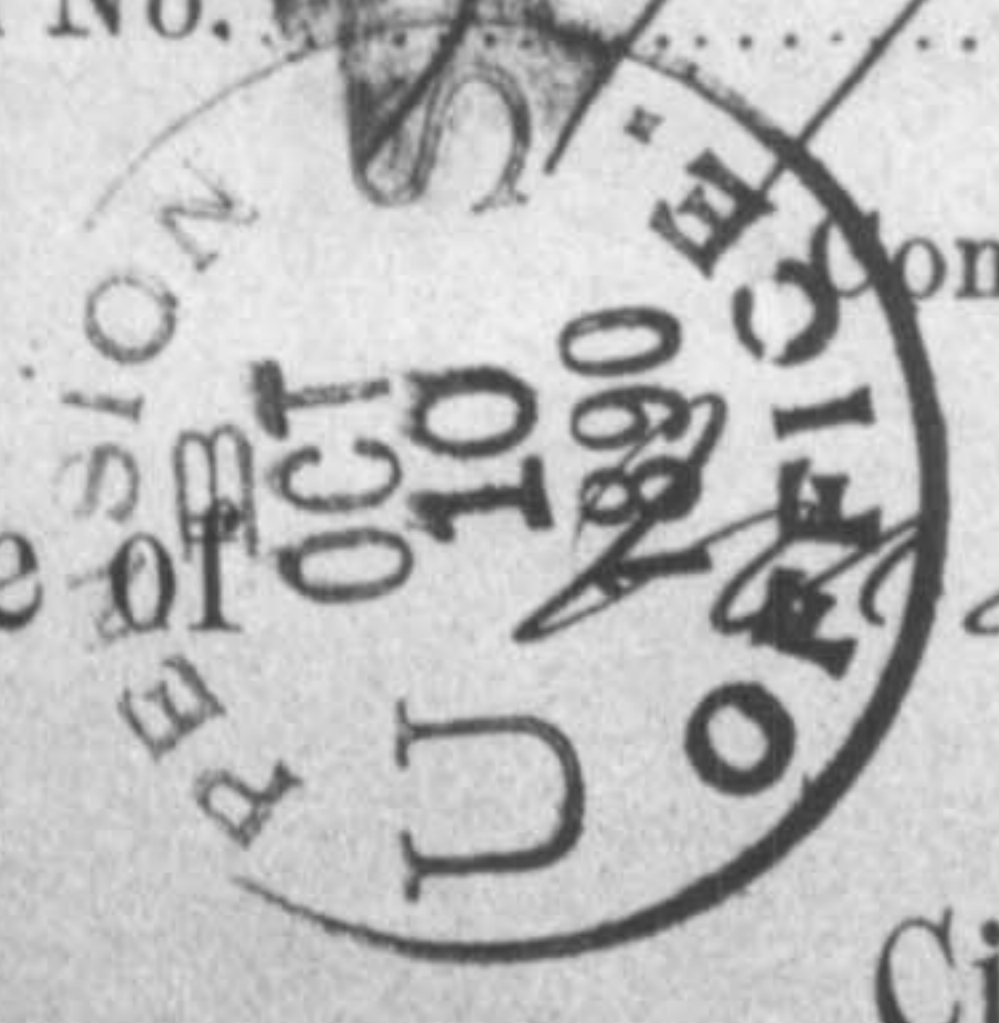


Claim No. 77468 of James H. Bowser, late private of Company D 30 Regiment, U.S.C.V. Volunteers,

I served in Co D 30 U.S.C.V. I know that at Petersburg July 30/64 my former comrade James H. Bowser was struck in the back by a piece of shell and that all during rest of his service he suffered from pain across the small of his back & kidneys and that he also contracted rheumatism about same time and place & I know these facts from personal observation of his symptoms of suffering

And he has no interest in the claim of James H. Bowser for Pension
