DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

To be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of its Seal.

ON THIS *6th* day of *January* A. D. one thousand *nine* hundred and *four* personally appeared before me *Justice of the Peace* the *Justice of the Peace* court, the same being a court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid *Annie M. Fisher* aged *57* years, a resident of the *town* of *Ridgely*, county of *Caroline*, State of *Md.*, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is a widow of *Eli Fisher*, who enlisted under the name of *Eli Fisher* at *Camp Belgium* on the *10th* day of *Nov.* A. D. 18*64*, in *U.S.C. 106* (Here state rank, company, and regiment if in military service, or vessel if in the navy.)
