aforesaid case as follows:

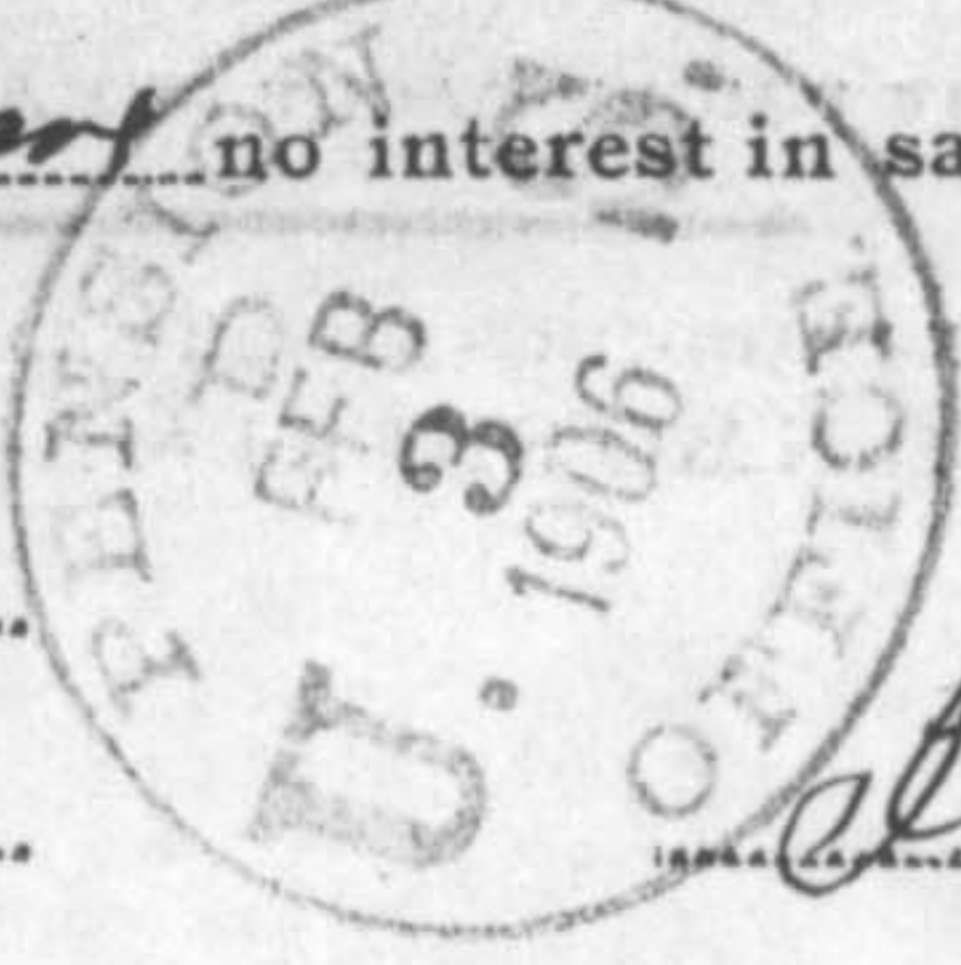
NOTE.—Affiants should state how long they have known soldier, how often they have seen him on an average during their acquaintance with
