1 I am 58 years of age.

2 P. O. and residence Grassboro Md.

3 I have known this claimant ever  
 4 since she was about sixteen years  
 5 of age. lived neighbor to her. Knew  
 6 her parents.

7 Her maiden name was Thomas.  
 8 She was not married before she  
 9 married Fisher. Eli Fisher

10 I knew Eli for a while before  
 11 he married claimant.

12 As far as I know he was not  
 13 married before he married claimant.  
 14 ant.

15 I had no personal knowledge  
 16 of their marriage. but I lived on  
 17 adjoining farm to them at the  
 18 time of their marriage and heard  
 19 of their marriage. and lived on  
 20 adjoining farms to them while  
 21 they lived together after their mar-  
 22 riage.

23 They lived together a year or more then  
 24 he was sent to prison and I never  
 25 saw him again.

26 He and claimant did not live  
 27 together after he was sent to prison  
 28 I never heard whether they were  
 29 divorced.
