

GENERAL AFFIDAVIT.

Note. Write an affidavit just as you would write a letter, stating all the facts, circumstances, dates and places, as correctly as you can remember, and state what opportunities you have had of knowing the facts, whether from personal knowledge and observation &c.

State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, SS:
In the matter of Eli Fisher

ON this Twentieth day of July 1897.

Personally came before me, a Justice of the Peace in and for aforesaid City and State, George Stewart, aged 75 years, and William Bell, aged 49 years, citizens of the town of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, Post Office Address.

State of Maryland, well known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit, and who, being duly sworn, declare in relation to the aforesaid case, as follows: that

I George Stewart have known Eli Fisher before and ever since the war of the rebellion of the States I was in the same Regiment with him in the war and have known him to complain of having the Rheumatism right after the close of the war and I am satisfied he is not able to do any work to earn a living

William Bell states that he knew Eli Fisher after he come out of the army and that then he complained of having the Rheumatism and knows he is not able to do any hard work
