Statement. Special examination was directed to determine whether the claimant had remarried or forfeited title since the soldier's death, and the evidence secured on special examination in the vicinity of her home is not adverse.

It is shown, however, that she lived at Cape May, New Jersey, for a year or more since the soldier's death.
