Sir:

Relative to the above cited claim for pension you are advised that claimant in her declaration claims pension for a child by the name of Thelma L. Cornish, born April 5, 1903, while the copy of the baptismal record shows that Finer L. Cornish was born April 8, 1903, this discrepancy should be explained, under oath, and the correct name of the child born on said date should be given.

Claimant should also furnish testimony of some one who knew the soldier prior to his enlistment in the United Service showing whether or he served in any organization prior to March 21, 1864, and if so, the name of the company and regiment should be given, with the dates of enlistment and discharge.

This letter should be returned with the evidence.
