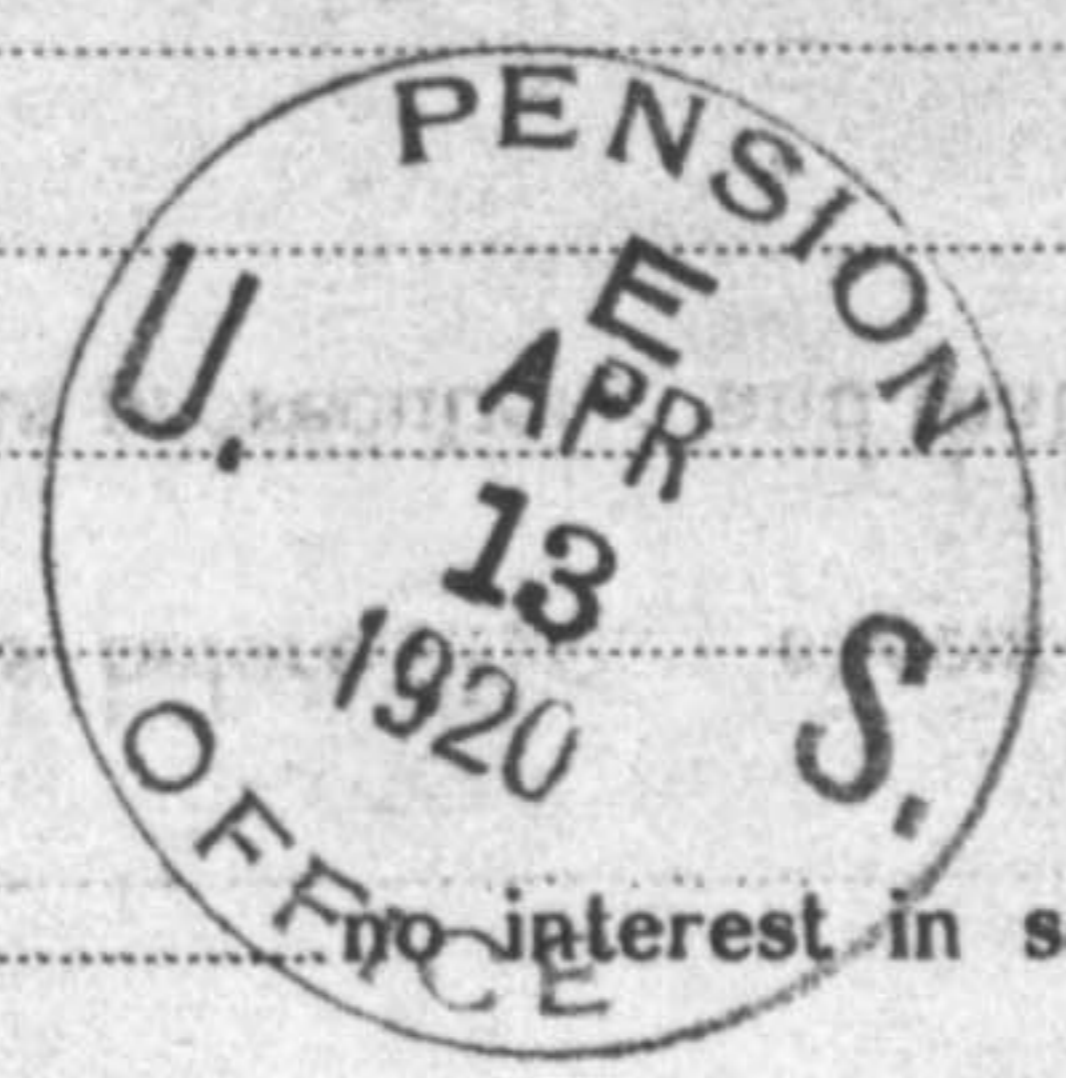
IN the matter of Claim of Mary E Cornish, widow of Joseph E Cornish,
