

28 and I do not know the names of his parents for certain, his  
29 mother may have been named Matilda Cornish, and my late hus-  
30 band has no living brothers or sisters.

31 Q. How many times have you been married?

32 A. Never but one time and that was to Joseph Cornish.

33 Q. How many times was Joseph Cornish married?

34 A. I was his second wife, and the first wife was Rebecca  
35 Cornish but I never knew her though I am told that she died  
36 in Baltimore about one year and a half prior to my marriage  
37 to him. The children of Joseph Cornish by that former wife  
38 are still living and I have heard no talk from them or any-  
39 body else as to any other marriage on his part.

40 I was living at 909 Harford avenue at date of the death  
41 of Joseph Cornish, with my children, and I lived there one  
42 year and over after his death, going then to Cape May N J  
43 and living one year, and then lived at 661 W Mulberry street  
44 in Baltimore for a year or more, leaving there in 1915, and  
45 located next next door to 909 Harford avenue with Tiney  
46 Johnson a colored woman, and was there from January to May,  
47 going then to 925 E Madison street and lived until October  
48 of that year, then at 828 Stirling street until in June 1916,  
49 and from there I moved to my present address 832 Stirling  
50 street though I am employed at 19 Merrymount Road with Mrs  
51 G.H. Lentz as a cook and been there for two years. I moved  
52 often because I have lived in furnished rooms. I have been  
53 employed as a laundress in my own home until going to Mrs  
54 Lentz. I have lived with no man in the relation of a wife  
55 or housekeeper or mistress since the death of Joseph Cornish.  
56 I was never divorced from the soldier Joseph Cornish.

58 Q. Who would know that you have not remarried since the  
59 death of Joseph Cornish? A. By William Johnson of 909 Har-  
60 ford avenue, Marcellus Kain of Pierce st near Pine street,  
61 Rev H Williams my pastor, Thomas Abernathy of 428 Ashland Ave.
