6 Q. What was the statement that your mother was living
 7 with Jackson based upon? A. I meant this: that Jackson had
 8 a bad influence over her while renting a room at her house
 9 but I did not mean that he was sleeping with mother or
 10 slipping into her room whenever he felt like it.

11 I know of no other man who has rented rooms at the house
 12 of my mother. I have no financial interest in this claim.

13 I am not on good terms with my mother but I will say
 14 that she has always been a good woman and easily influenced.

15 I was afraid of that man Jackson and mother was afraid
 16 of him and I believe that he would have killed mother if
 17 she did'nt give up her money to him. I have heard the fore-
 18 going deposition read and it is correct.
