Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 84; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 4 inches; weight, 130 pounds; age, 47 years. General physical condition below par.

Fairly well nourished but tissues are soft. Has rather debilitated appearance.

No crepitation or deformity of the joints or pain on manipulation or other evidence of rheumatism.

No evidence Pleurisy. Auscultation and percussion show the lungs to be in healthy condition.

Area of hepatic and splenic dulness is about normal but there is tenderness on palpation in the hepatic and splenic regions and very marked in the epigastrium. Tongue is flabby and has thick whitish coating. Bowels are irregular.

Rectum: Some congestion of the mucous membrane with engorgement of the hemorrhoidal veins but no hemorrhoids.

He claims to suffer severely with rheumatism with much pain and burning in the stomach with vomiting.
