

# For Officer's or Comrade's Testimony.

I, John Fortie a resident of Balto 651 Mulberry St  
 in the County of Baltimore State of Maryland late  
Sarge of Company B of the 30<sup>th</sup> Regiment of U.S. & T  
 on oath, depose and say, that I was well acquainted with Thomas Carter  
 late a Capt in Company B of the 30<sup>th</sup> Regiment of U.S. & T  
 of the war of 1861; that at the time of his enlistment, said Thomas Carter  
 was in good health

Here state condition of soldier's health at time of enlistment.

and while in the military service of the United States, in the line of his duty, and without fault or im-  
 proper conduct of his own, on or about the May day of 1864  
 at Manassa Gap in the State of Virginia

State time and place of disability, and if by wound in battle, state name of battle; if by accident, state the circumstances; and if by sickness, state the cause and nature of the disease.

from exposure in the line of duty  
He was taken sick, being the Sarge  
having charge of the sick he was sent to  
the field hospital for treatment. but the  
ambulance broke down and he was treated  
in the camp during the entire time and  
on certain time he was able to do duty. He  
left him behind when the Regt was sent  
to Fort Fisher in 1864-65 and since his  
discharge he has been been disabled by blindness  
for 1 year 1869-70 and is now suffering from  
Amputation of his right leg

State your source of information.

I know these facts from in the army and since a horse kick  
 and I have no interest whatever in the prosecution of this claim for pension.
