On this sixth day of January
 A. D. 1890, personally appeared
 before me, a Justice of the Peace
 within and for the State and
 City aforesaid, Benjamin Adams
 aged 55 years, a resident of the
 City of Baltimore, and State of
 Maryland, who being sworn accor-
 ding to law, declares that he is a
 pensioner of the United States,
 enrolled at the Washington Agen-
 cy, at the rate of Six dollars per
 month, certificate No 194780 by
 reason of disability from "Double
 Inguinal Hernia," incurred in the
 military service of the United
 States, while serving as a private
 in Co. G 30th Regt of US Col'd 7.
 That he believes himself entitled
 to an increase of pension on
 account of disability resulting
 from cause aforesaid, for the fol-
 lowing reasons, viz: That he is wh-
 olly unable to perform manual
 labor, of any kind whatever, and
 suffers from pains in the Groin, and
 back, with great weakness in his
 entire body, and often, when at
