

ARMY OF THE UNITED STATES CERTIFICATE OF DISABILITY FOR DISCHARGE.



Shadrach Bolden Private of Captain George W. Bunnell's Company, (Co.) of the nineteenth Regiment of United States Infantry was enlisted by Col Wm Pinner of the 2d Regiment of U. S. I at Queen Anne Md on the eighteenth day of December 1863, to serve three years; he was born in Queen Anne in the State of Maryland is Twenty one (21) years of age, 5 feet 6 inches high, Griff complexion, Black eyes, Black hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Farmer. During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty 60 days.* Said Shadrach-Bolden is totally blind, caused by inflammation of the eyes contracted while in the performance of his duty as a soldier.

Bunnell's Company, and find him incapable of performing the duties of a soldier because of Total opacity of both cornea producing total blindness, resulting from an attack of purulent ophthalmia, contracted while in the service.
