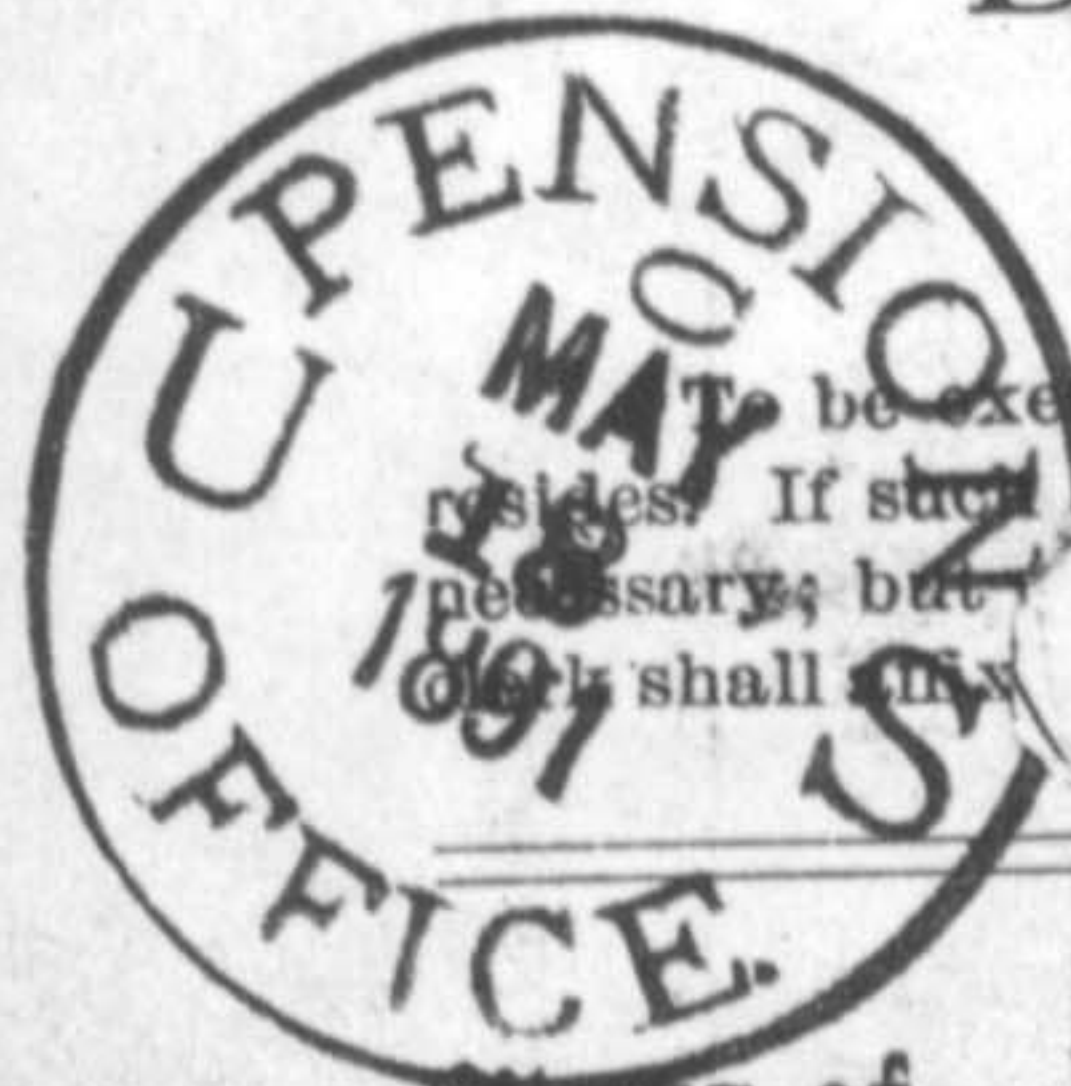


# DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.



to be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in the State, city, or county where said officer resides. If such officer has a seal and uses it upon such paper, no certificate of a county clerk or prothonotary or a clerk of a court shall be necessary; but if no seal is used by the officer before whom the declaration is executed, then a clerk of a court of record or a county or city clerk shall certify to the signature and official character of said officer.

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was

honorably discharged 1865, and died 9<sup>th</sup> May 1891

That she was married under the name of Mary F. Anderson to said

Shadrack Boulden on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1883,

by Rev. Mr. Allen, at Balto. Md. there being no legal

barrier to said marriage. that her husband Shadrack Boulden

had been previously married former wife died Dec 1877

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Shadrack Boulden

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor; that names and dates of birth of all the

children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under

the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.
