He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for Act June 27, 1890

[Original, increase, restoration, &c.]

Rheumatism in back and sides - diarrhoea - have 15 years - Piles which I said - have kidney disease - something growing on my neck and right leg. I have Catarrh sometimes

Here give the statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 90; respiration, 24; temperature, 98; height, 5 feet 6 inches; weight, 140 pounds; age, 47 years. General physical condition good

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.

Rheumatism - There is slight tenderness over lumbar muscles without atrophy or swelling - heart normal  
diarrhoea - no objective evidence of  
diarrhoea.

Piles - There are three external hemorrhoidal tumors, one of which is an inch & a half in circumference, and two 1/2 inch each in circumference. These tumors are sensitive, bleeding and ulcerated.

The actual and probable origin of every existing disability must be fully set forth.

Whenever a disability is shown, or is believed to be due to or aggravated by vicious habits the opinion of the board must be stated. When not due to such habits this fact must be stated.

disease of kidneys - no objective evidence of disease of kidneys - urine normal.  
disease of neck - a small colloid growth 1/2 inch in circumference, situated just outside of the Sternocleidomastoid muscle.

disease of right leg - There is no objective evidence of disease of right leg. There is a fatty tumor four inches in circumference situated midway the leg over the fibula.

Catarrh - There is naso-pharyngeal catarrh with slight discharge of mucus.
