Under the Acts of June 27th, 1890, and May 9, 1900, and Commissioner of Pensions' Order No. 78,
of March 15, 1904, on Account of Old Age.

To be executed before some officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. That said disabilities are not due to vicious habits, and are, to the best of his knowledge and belief, of a permanent character.

That he has not applied for pension under application No. 611.418 That he is a pensioner

under Certificate No. 611.418 under increase of pension

If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application if one was made.

That he has not been employed in the MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE otherwise than as stated above. That he makes this Declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Pension-Roll of the United States, under the provisions of the Acts of June 27, 1890, and May 9, 1900, and under Order No. 78, March 15, 1904, of the Commissioner of Pensions, allowing pension on account of old age. He hereby appoints—

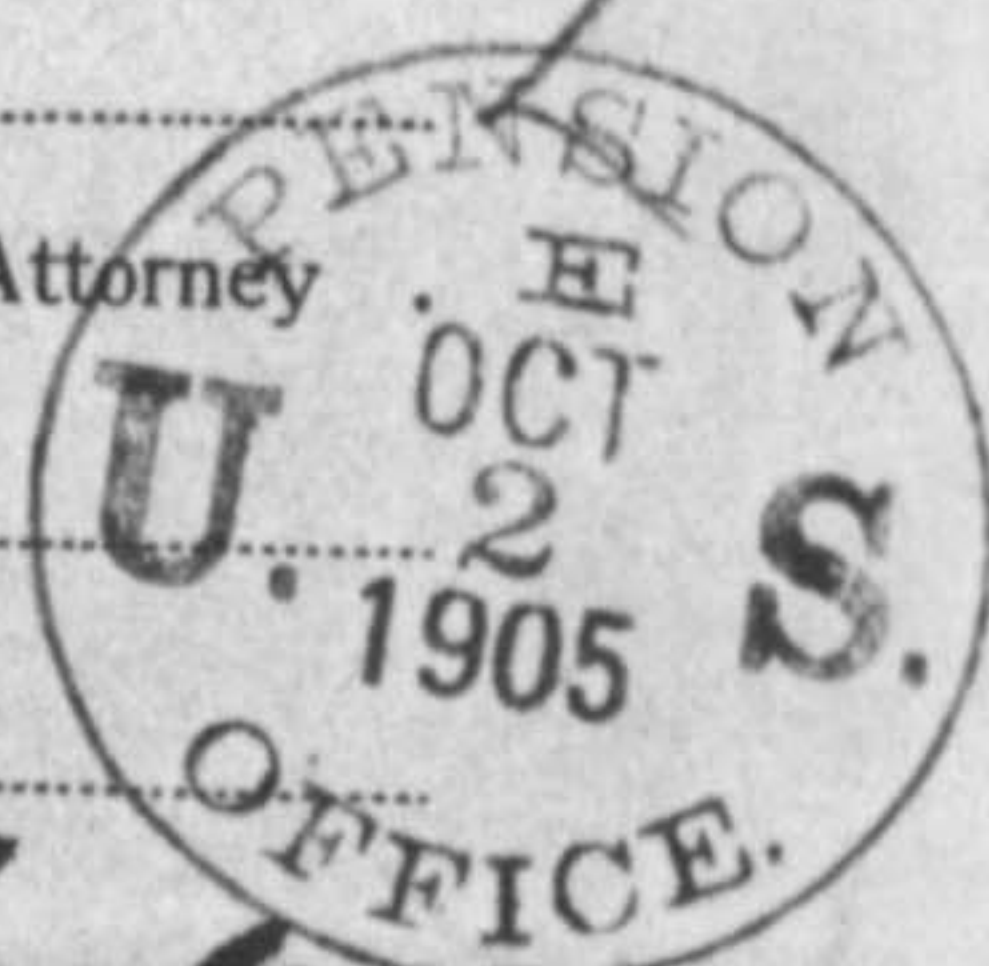
