declaration of June 20/92 was prepared by Beale). I think I  
have kidney disease because I have trouble with passing  
water. I don't know what dyspepsia is. No sir, I  
do not know E. E. Warren, by name unless he is the  
man who swore me the first time I was in Lloyd's. It  
was a different ~~man~~ <sup>Squire</sup> who swore me there close from Mr  
Lloyd's office when I took my witnesses there. I do not  
know that Squire's name. I do not know Squire Tubman and  
I was never sworn but once at Lloyd's office; that was the  
time I first applied - and I was never sworn but one time  
at the office there close from Lloyd's. That is all the times  
I was sworn in my case that I now remember.  
I have a poor memory now, but I am quite sure I  
never swore to any paper that the young man with  
glasses fixed up. - I don't remember anyone there  
but Mr Lloyd writing the papers in my case.  
I did not pay Mr Lloyd any fee when I got my pension.  
The gov't took out \$10<sup>00</sup> for him as I am allowed. I have  
no agreement for the increased claim. No sir, neither of  
the clerks at Mr Lloyd's ever signed any sworn to any  
papers for me. No one was with me when I applied  
for increased, but while I was in the office I met  
Cook or Cooper there. I now remember that it was  
sometime after I applied for increased before I got the  
two witnesses. I now remember I was there and made  
increased claim before and I had to get two witnesses after-  
ward, but I can't just explain this. I got \$36<sup>00</sup> in Sept/93.  
The time we were paid at the P.O. but always got \$30<sup>00</sup> before  
and since. Yes sir, I fully understand the contents of  
this deposition and my answers have been correctly put  
down.
