On this day and date below written, personally appeared the affiant whose signature is hereto affixed and being duly sworn according to law testified as follows:

"My name is William H. D. Wilson. I am 62 years old, and

I reside in Baltimore, Md. at No. 742 ^{Mar}arsche Street.

I was well-acquainted with Charles Grandison, the husband of the claimant in this case, and served in the same company and regiment with him. I remember that he suffered a great deal with rheumatism while in the service, especially when we were lying at Petersburg, Va. He had a great deal of rain there. He was sore and stiff, and his joints were swollen. I remember his going to sick call for this rheumatism. He also suffered from pain in the breast and shortness of breath, - I noticed while marching alongside of him that he suffered from this shortness of breath. I first noticed these troubles at Petersburg, and I believe he contracted them there, for he always seemed to be perfectly well before that.

I was quite intimate with him after I first knew him continually up to his death, and he never ceased to suffer from the troubles I have described, and finally died by cause of them.

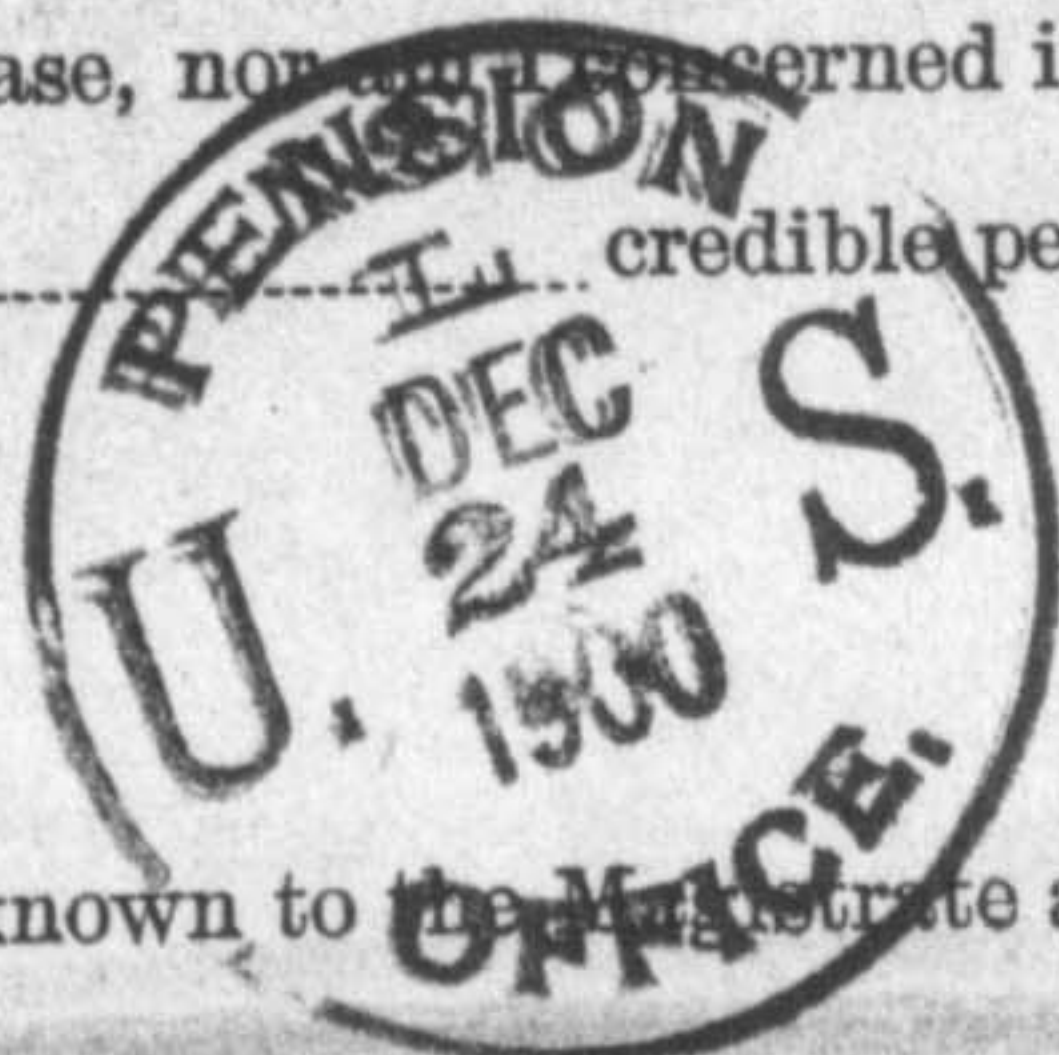
