Charles Grandison ^{and me} were comrades in the same Company B
39 United States Colored Infantry and both of us
were discharged on December the 14 1865, at Wilmington
North Carolina and mustered out of service ^{about the 18} at
Fort Federal Hill Baltimore the next day
after we were mustered out and several times after
that and he complain of suffering with the Rheumatism
and he never came from the affect and he suffered
with the Asthama and shortness of breath and he continued to
suffer and I saw him very frequently and he was
not able to perform any manual labor only
to carry a Sunket Basket and at times he was not
able to do that
