Kindly answer upon the reverse of this letter and return the same in the inclosed envelope, which requires no postage.

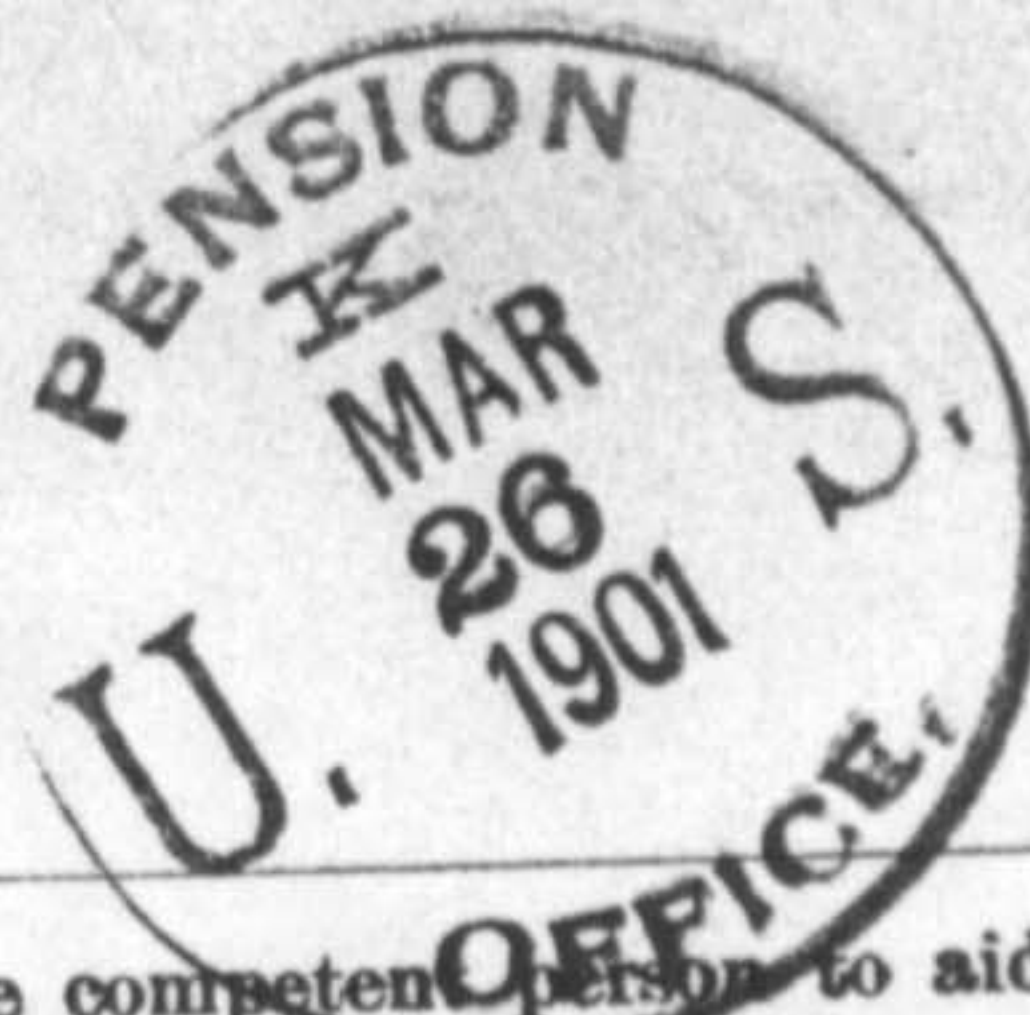
