Brogden deceased who was a private in Co. F. 39th Regiment United States Colored Troops, that there is two and only two children under sixteen years now living which she had by said John H. Brogden deceased her husband, said children being named, aged and residing as follows. Elisha Brogden aged 11 years on the 6th day of July. A.D. 1866 and Mary Lane Brogden Aged Six years on the 23rd day of September. A.D. 1866. said children residing with, and supported by, her and she further declares that the Physician who attended her at the birth of Elisha Brogden is now dead, and that Dr Sappington attended at the birth of Mary Lane Brogden whose affidavit accompanies this
