" He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for Original I have Rheumatism in my back and weakness in my knees can't do any work if I lift or stoop I give away. I can't hear when there is no noise - In windy weather water runs out of my eyes I have lost my teeth - "

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with pars. 5, 6, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889. Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 16; temperature, 98; height, 5 feet 9 inches; weight, 155 pounds; age, 48 years. There is apparently existing tenderness over lumbar region - No other objective evidence of disease of Back. No other Rheumatism - The apex beat of heart is not discernible. The pt sound of heart is very faint with friction sounds over left side of chest; no distinct murmur. His hearing is $\frac{2}{40}$ both ears. There is displacement of lachrymal puncta - no inflammation of tarsal cartilages. Ptosis of both eyes, loss of all molar teeth on lower jaw and all but three on upper jaw - Except as above there is no disability.

The Conditions of joints are Normal, otherwise it would have been stated above - Only hears conversation three times ordinary pitch.

Rate for EACH cause of disability. He is, in our opinion, entitled to a $\frac{6}{18}$ rating for the disability caused by Rheumatism and heart disease for that caused by for disease of heart and for loss of teeth for that caused by _____
