 57 he is a Methodist preacher and he travels about a
 58 good bit; I don't know when he is just now; he
 59 may be at Snow Hill for all I know. Then there is
 60 Leah Roley, widow of "Elgie" Roley; she lives near
 61 Giddletown Hill, Worcester Co., Md. Then there is
 62 "Mandy" Carlier, wife of John Henry Carlier, &
