 5 of Philadelphia all her life.
 6 She was born and reared in
 7 Worcester County Md and came
 8 to this city after her marriage
 9 to John Adams a fireman on
 10 steamboats plus was her first
 11 husband. I lived near her
 12 parents at Snow Hill and came
 13 to Baltimore shortly before John
 14 and Sarah Adams came and
 15 we were associates here until
 16 they moved to Philadelphia
 17 five or six years ago. They
 18 were never divorced and I have
 19 not heard of no separation be-
 20 tween them and they raised a
 21 family of children. One is the
 22 child of my oldest sister I forget
 23 to mention. John Adams is
 24 the only man Sarah was
 25 my married to I am certain.
