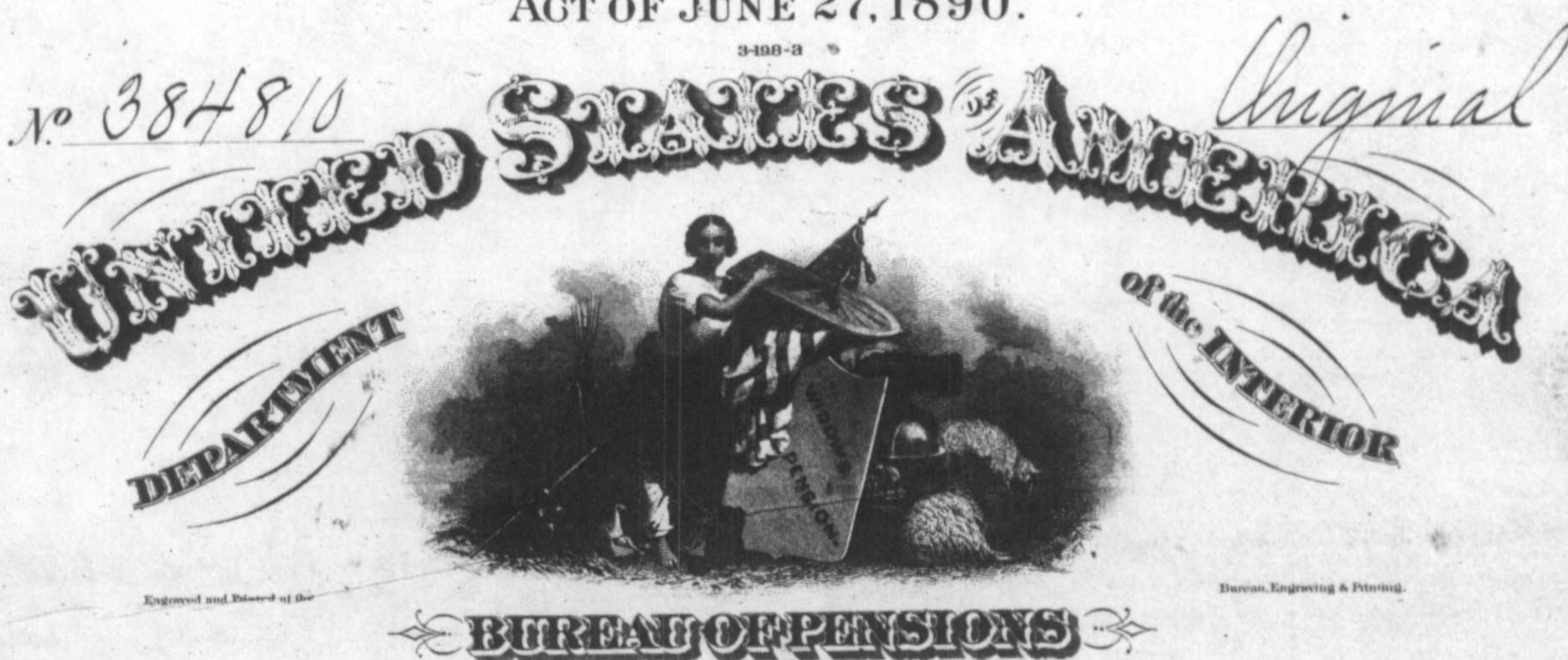

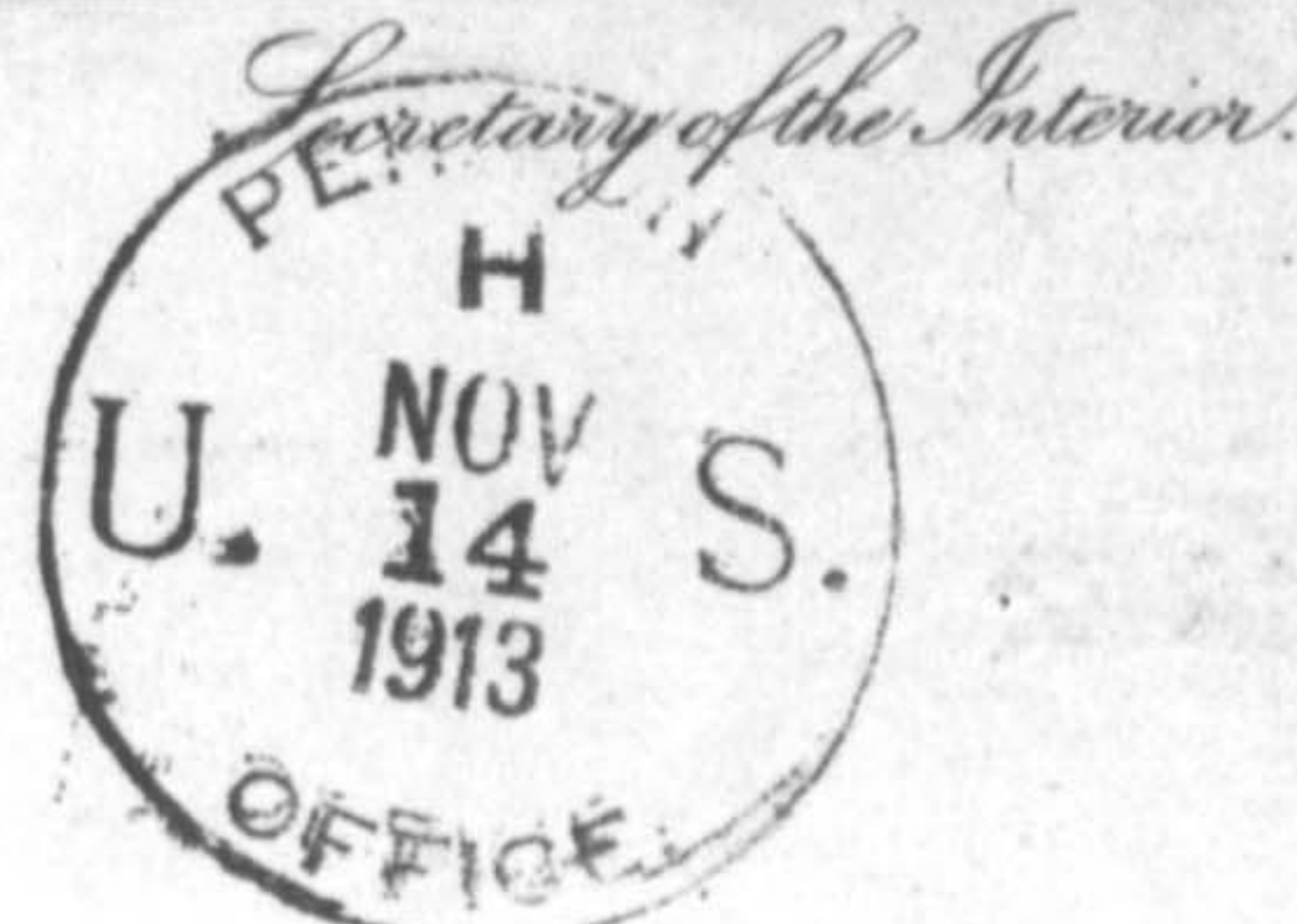
ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.
