That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Petersburg, in the State of Virginia, on or about the 30 day of July, 1864 he contracted malarial fever

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a Teamster.

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a Teamster. That he is now totally disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.
