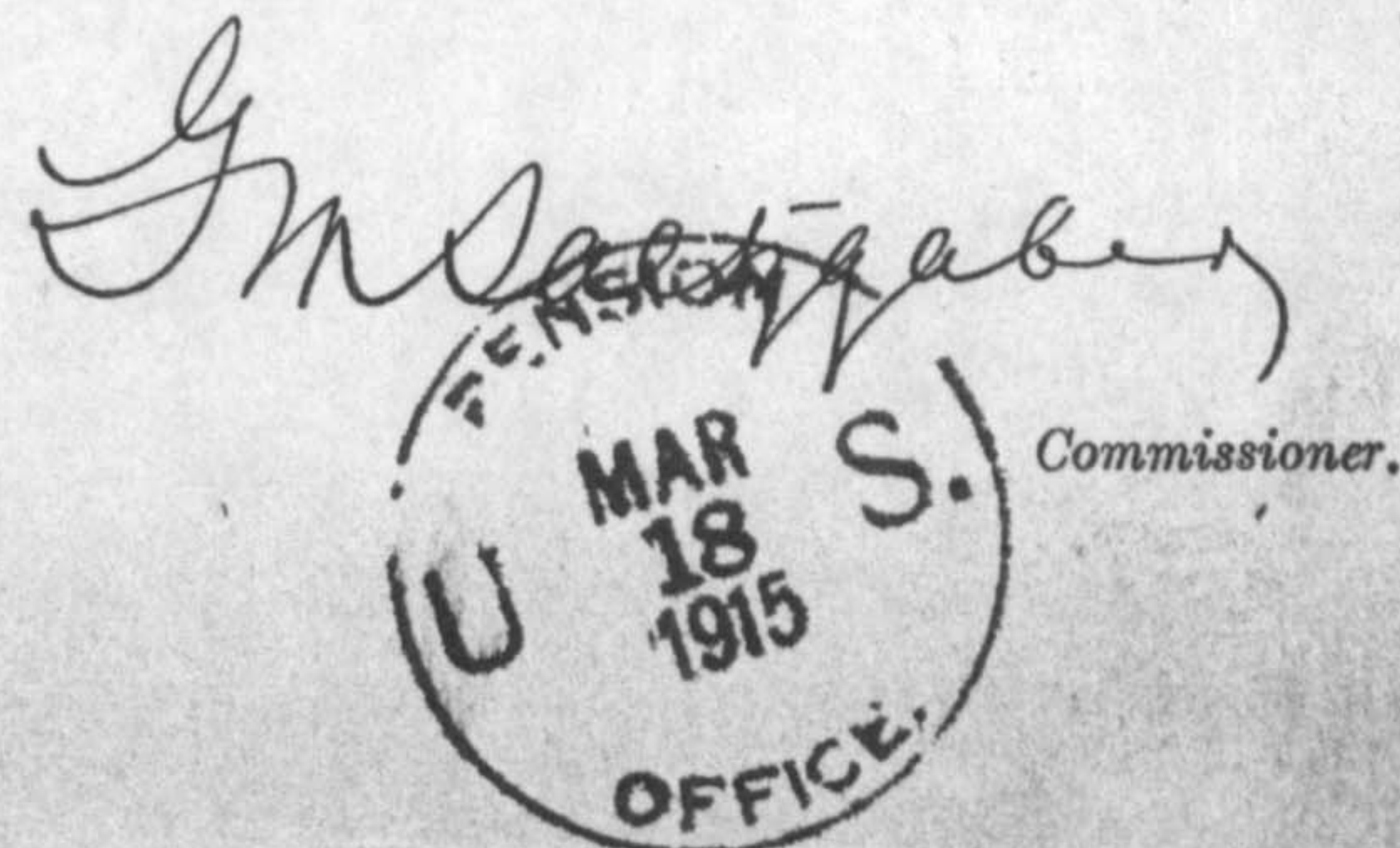

No. 1. Date and place of birth? Answer. Dec. 25, 1836 at Queen Anne's Co., Md.
The name of organizations in which you served? Answer. Co. E. 7th S. I. B. T.

No. 2. What was your post office at enlistment? Answer. Queen Anne's Co., Md.

No. 3. State your wife's full name and her maiden name. Answer. Sarah J. Bennett nee Brown

No. 4. When, where, and by whom were you married? Answer. June 2, 1890 at Baltimore, Md. by Rev. Peck.

No. 5. Is there any official or church record of your marriage? Answer. Yes.
If so, where? Answer. At Baltimore City Court House, Md.

No. 6. Were you previously married? If so, state the name of your former wife, the date of the marriage, and the date and place of her death or divorce. If there was more than one previous marriage, let your answer include all former wives. Answer. Yes

to Lucy Bryson who died before married Sarah.

No. 7. If your present wife was married before her marriage to you, state the name of her former husband, the date of such marriage, and the date and place of his death or divorce, and state whether he ever rendered any military or naval service, and, if so, give name of the organization in which he served.
