 am positive that she has not remarried since his death.

My knowledge of the above matter is from the fact that
 I am the brother-in-law of the above named applicant, and have
 been closely associated with the family.

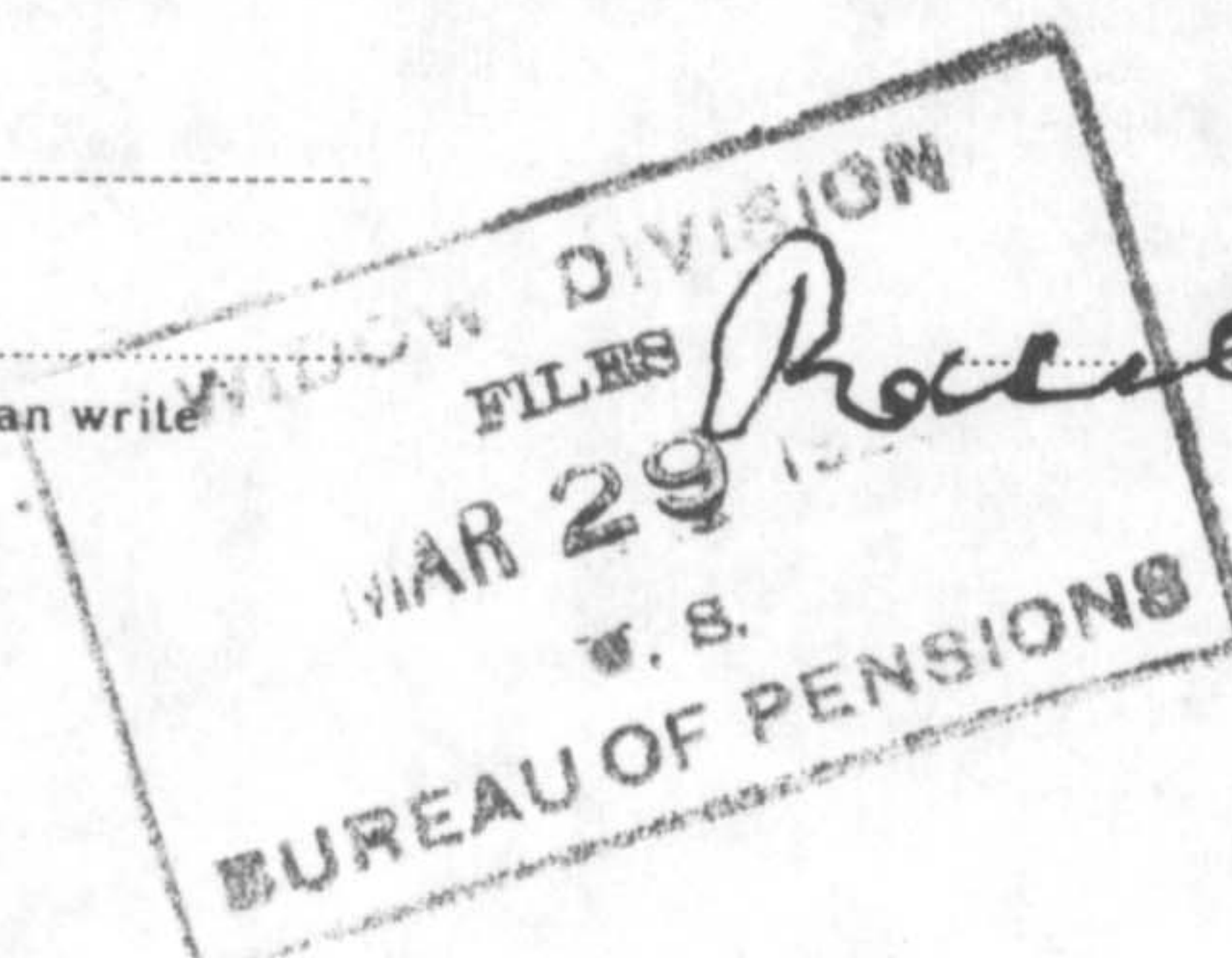
