are sister-in-laws of the above named applicant.



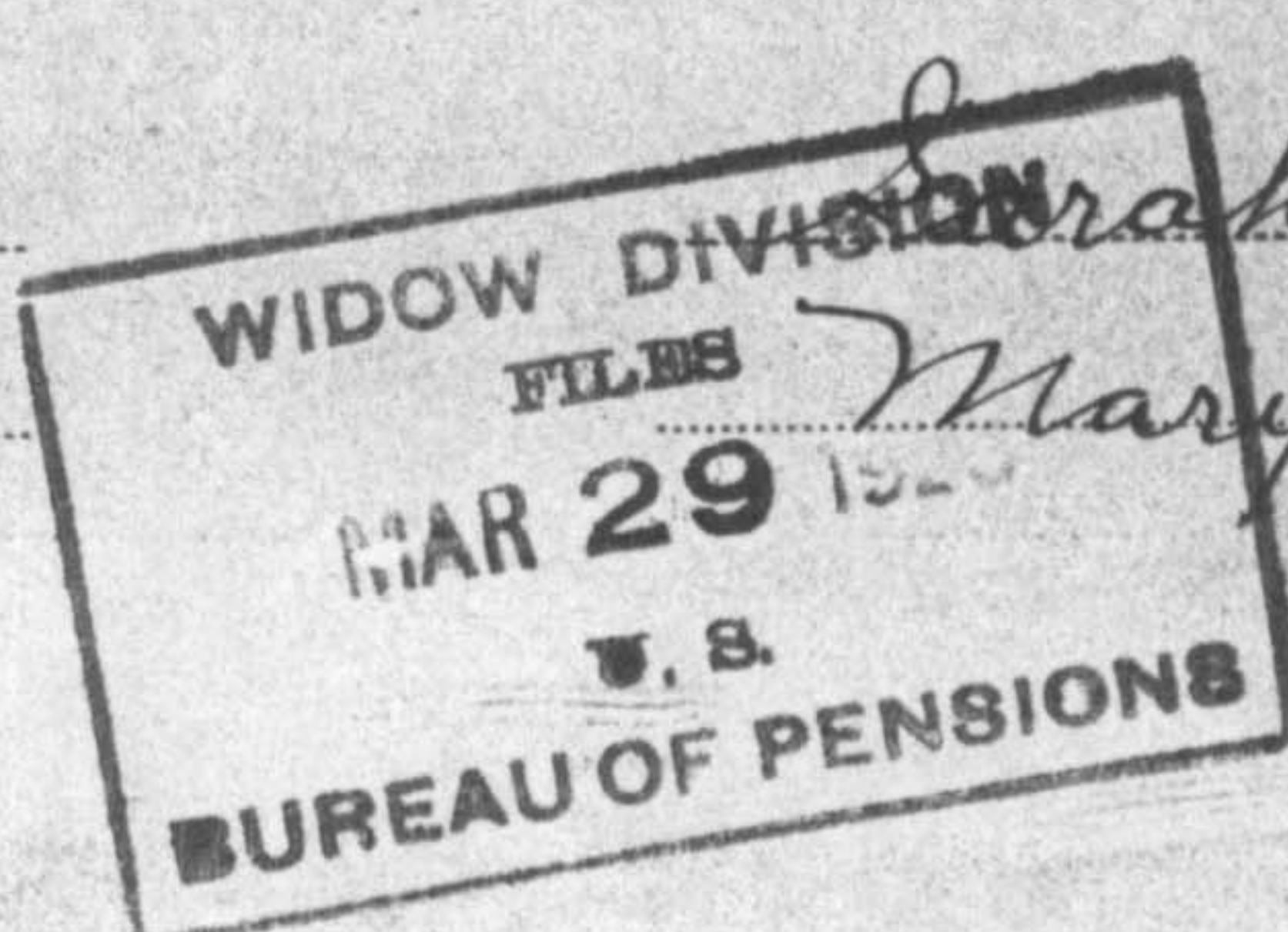
