Had Mumps while in the service and has piles as result which protrude and bleed at times and are very painful.
Weakness and pain in the small of back.
Also claims Rheumatism in the legs.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 72; respiration, 17; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 6 inches; weight, 151 pounds; age, 50 years. General physical condition is fair.
No evidence of results of Mumps at the present time.

Rectum: Has fringe of external piles surrounding the anus; with one internal piles protruding, 1/2 inch in diameter/ulcerated and bleeding. There is also an internal hemorrhoid, 1/4 inch in diameter which is not protruding.

No evidence of injury of right leg.

Rheumatism: Slight crepitation in knees with pain on motion in knees and ankles. No deformity in joints.

Heart and Lungs in good condition.

No other disability.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a 8/18 rating for the disability caused by Hemorrhoids, 4/18 for that caused by Rheumatism and 0 for that caused by mumps or injury to leg.
