Reference is made to the case of Annie L. Perkins, certificate No. 750,681.

The records show that payment was made April 29 on the voucher executed by you, as guardian, on the 21st for the month ended April 4, 1930, and the bureau is informed by the daughter of the pensioner that she died April 18. Please return the check for \$30, at once, as the payment was illegal, the pensioner having deceased prior to the date of the issuance of the check. If you have cashed the check, a refundment should be made at once in the form of a certified bank check, or New York draft, drawn in favor of the Disbursing Clerk, Bureau of Pensions.
