I commenced working for my father when I was 8 years old, and have been working ever since. I know I am about four years older than Moses, but I don't know his birthday. I know he is 16 years. I don't know the ages of Elijah and Jacob. My ~~for~~ mother has not married since my father's death, nor has she lived with any man. She has no property, and depends on me and my brother Moses and my sister.
