On this 12 day of January, 1894, at
 Baltimore, County of
 State of Maryland, before me, B. A. Halley, a
 Special Examiner of the Pension Office, personally appeared Lena
 Schulz, who, being by me first duly sworn to answer
 truly all interrogatories propounded to her during this Special Examination of aforesaid
 pension claim, deposes and says: I am 37 years
 old, Occupation, housewife. Residence
 and postoffice address, 784 Sarah
 Ann Street, Baltimore, Md. I
 have known Alice Barker about
 eight years. She has lived near
 me since I first knew her. Her
 husband had no property and
 since his death she has had noth-
 ing except what she could make
 by her labor, and too sick most
 of the time to do anything. She
 has been down in bed the
 last two weeks. She has no
 means. She has been coming
 to me for help and what
 little I could spare with her I
 did. I know she is a decent
 respectable woman and she
 has not remarried or lived
 with any man since her
 husband's death. I have
 understood the questions asked
 and my answers are correctly
