Sir:

In the above-cited claim for pension, there is required a copy of the public record, under seal or oath, showing the date of the soldier's death.

The claim further requires testimony of two credible witnesses who have personal knowledge of the facts to which they testify, showing whether the claimant has remarried since the date of the soldier's death.

Witnesses should state their ages, post office addresses, means of knowledge and length of acquaintance.

Do not fail to inscribe upon each piece of evidence filed the soldier's name, service and number of the claim.
