

Dec. 14, 1883; they are still living and with me; the ages are taken from the book, and are recorded in my husband's own hand-writing; we were never married until Sept. 10, 1891; I am sure of that; I had joined the church about a year before, and the pastor, Rev. J. L. Thomas, married us; my maiden name was Alice Scott; soldier had never been married before; I have not been married since soldier's death; I have no property or income, except the proceeds of my own labor; for the past 24 years of our cohabitation we lived at 15 Water's St.; then moved to where we now live, and where soldier died, that is just across the street; soldier repaired locks and sewing machines and always worked for himself. Rev. Father Stern, a catholic priest of St. Alphonsus church baptized ~~him~~ and a priest at St. ^{Alphonsus} ~~Alphonsus~~ ^{church} ~~Alphonsus~~ ^{episcopal} ~~church~~ at birth, but both about same time during an epidemic of fever; I can give date; I had no physician when the children were born; my mother now dead, always attended me. I
