Joseph Cooper was Sgt. in my company. Chas. Cole and the names you call to me from the list of comrades I do remember. My piles first appeared with an itching. That was shortly after I came out of the service.

My eyes never troubled in the army, about six years ago they began to be dim.

I have had dyspepsia for more than ten years. If I eat anything rich with grease I have a burning sensation and I have to be careful what I eat. I used to could eat anything.

I have been troubled with the fluttering pain in my heart only since the war. First noticed it after the war cant say when
