

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

State of Maryland City of Baltimore County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 7th day of March A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninty nine, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, James Armstrong, aged 60 years, a resident of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the United States, enrolled at the Washington Pension Agency at the rate of Six dollars per month, under Certificate No. 664,927, by reason of disability from Rheumatism (Here name the disability or disabilities for which now pensioned.)

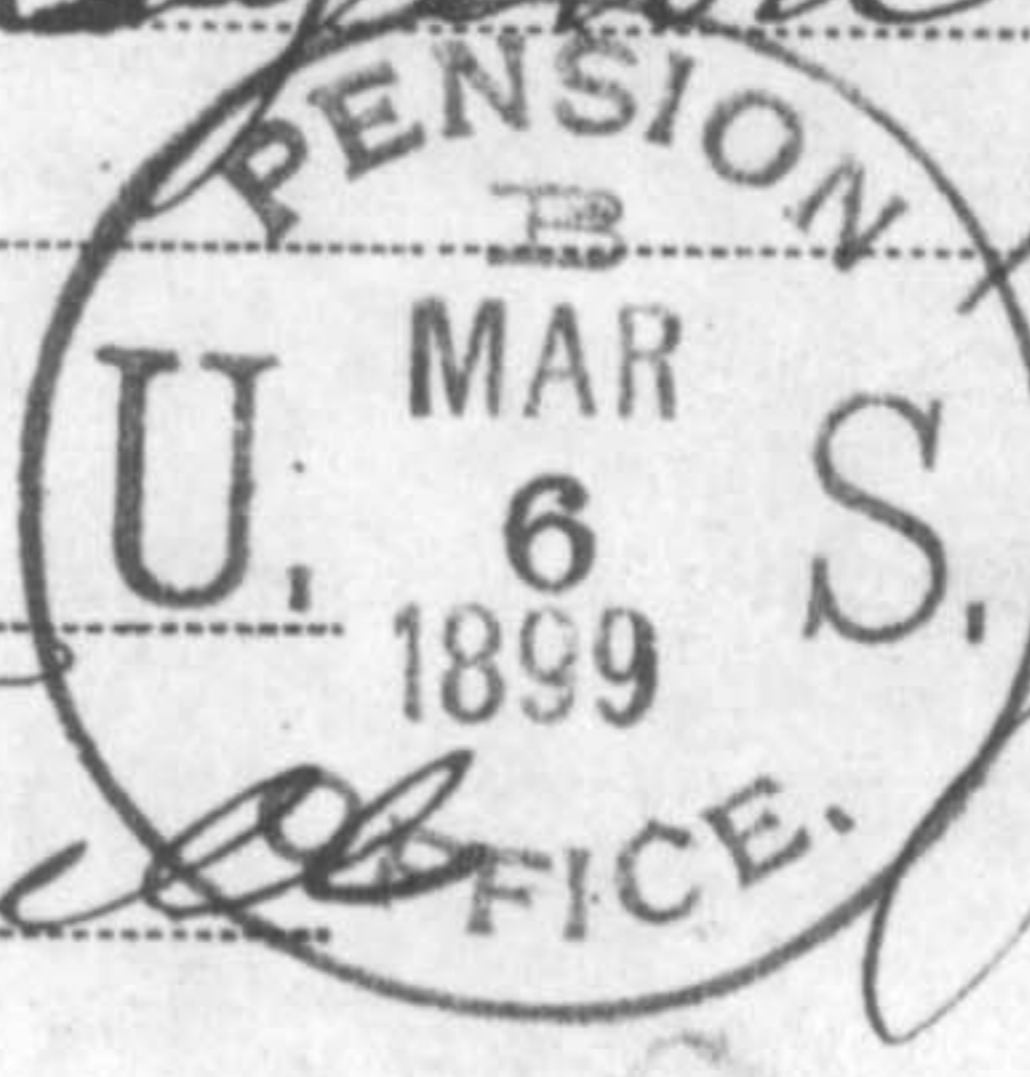
