Jan. 13/65. left on board transport, sick.
Jan. 19. 65. returned to duty. June 15/65
"for duty to ~~at~~ board. June 17/65
"for at-ent leave." Sept 8. 65. sent to
Gen. Hays. Oct. 19/65. Gen. Hays sent
back. Oct. 24/65. Gen. Hays, to duty.

The medical records show him treated as
follows *as per*, Sept 7 to Oct
4, 1865. Intermittent fever,
quarantined, returned to duty.
Acting additional forklift.
