We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant, who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred

in the service, viz: Wound of right ankle, Rheumatism, Injury of right groin or testicle and deafness.

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for ORIGINAL

[Original, increase, restoration, &c.]

Claims to have received gun shot wound of right ankle, which causes much pain in cloudy weather.

Suffers with lump in groin as result of injury, which weakens the leg and causes pain at times.

Makes no claim for deafness.

Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 88; respiration, 19; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 7 inches; weight, 142 pounds; age, 54 years. General physical condition fair.

Scar of gun shot wound on inner aspect of right ankle at lower border of the external malleolus.

Scar is 1/2 inch in diameter, adherent, dragging and slightly sensitive.

Ball passed backward and emerged 1 1/2 inches from point of entrance on inner aspect of tendo achillis.

Scar of exit is 1/2 inch long by 1/4 inch wide, adherent, dragging and sensitive.

There was no injury to the bone. The wound probably causes pain when walking.

Rheumatism: Slight crepitation in the right knee and both ankles. No deformity of the joints.

Sensitiveness of muscles in the lumbar regions and about the hips with severe pain in stooping and lifting.

Has apparent difficulty in picking objects from the floor.

Heart and Lungs are normal.

Right inguinal hernia, indirect, incomplete, contained within the canal. Tumor is two inches long by 1 1/2 inches wide, easily reducible and can be retained by proper truss.

External ring is intact.

No evidence of disease or injury to the testicle.

No affection of the groin other than the hernia.

Ears: Membranes normal in appearance. Hearing good.

No other disability exists.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is in our opinion, entitled to a 4/18 rating for the disability caused by Gun shot wound of right ankle - 6/18 for that caused by Rheumatism, and Specific for that caused by Hernia
