answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him, deposes and says I am 57 years old and my occupation coal and wood dealer. My P.O. address is 588 W. Preston St. Baltimore, Md. I know Adeline Kinney and have known her ever since about three years before she and John Kinney got married. They lived near neighbors to me then. She was never married before she married John Kinney. John Kinney was never married before he married Adeline but once and that was to Henrietta Kemp. She died within a year or two after their marriage. I saw her dead body. I was at the house after she died but did not go to her funeral. John Kinney remained a widower some four or five years on such a matter and then married the claimant. This claimant has not remarried or lived with any man unlawfully since John Kinney died. John Kinney was ord. Sgt of Co. B, 7th US Inf. I saw him acting as such at Cason's farm at Harwood near Richmond Va in Dec 1865. My regiment of 39 US Inf was in the rear and I directed him up in the fort as I had known him since he was a small boy. My answers are correctly recorded here.
