appeared William Zell, who, being by me first duly sworn to

answer truly all interrogatories propounded to him, deposes and says I am 48 years old
and am by occupation job worker. My P.O. address
is 300 Diamond St. Baltimore Md. I know Adeline Kinsey the
claimant and was well acquainted with John Kinsey her late husband in his life until I got ac-
quainted with him in about 1867. When I first got
acquainted with him he was an unmarried
man and I understood he had never been married
before then but that fall or winter he married a woman
named Henrietta who died about a year afterwards
leaving a child by soldier that I raised. I
did not see Henrietta dead as I was out of the city
when she died but I was told when I got back
the following year by every one that she was dead
and I took her child to raise. I got ac-
quainted with this claimant in about 1869
she was then unmarried and a young girl
17 or 18 years old and I never heard of her being
married to any one except to John Kinsey.
She married him somewhere about 1872 or 1873
and they lived together till he died without
separation or divorce - She has not
remarried or lived with any man in unlawful
relations since he died. I don't know
anything about the identity of John Kinsey's
claimant's husband as the man who served
under that name in Leo B. Reynolds' except
from what he told me. I married his sister
and he told me she was a sergeant in
said company and that is all I know. He
got back from the army before I did and
I never saw him in service. I served in the 19th
