Invalid Pension.

ON THIS 28th day of May A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty eight

personally appeared before me Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court of Record within and for the county and State aforesaid Robert Young

aged 47 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

Robert Young who was ENROLLED on the 21 day of July, 18 63, in Company B of the 4 regiment of U. S. C. T. Infantry

commanded by Capt Samuel Gillingham and was honorably DISCHARGED at Washington on the 4 day of May, 18 65

personal description is as follows: Age 23 years; height 5 feet 5 3/4 inches; complexion black hair black; eyes black

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty at Washington in the State of District of Columbia on or about the Fall day of 1865, he was prostrated with

Rheumatism from exposure at Fort Fisher & doing guard duty That also at Washington while in hospital he suffered greatly from Piles contracted about same time as the Rheumatism also from exposure He was treated for these diseases by Surgeons Mitchell & Odorice. Dr. Mitchell injected morphine or other medicine in his right leg about 3 1/2 inches above his ankle & the wound made thereby has never wholly healed up That he also operated upon hemorrhoid Piles. He was in Fort Detrick Hospital Washington about 3 or 4 months or more That on July 26 1870 he enlisted in C. H. 24 U. S. Regulars Infantry

That he was treated in hospitals as follows:

and while serving therein suffered from Rheumatism & Piles & was treated for the latter at the Hospital at Fort McCawet Texas by Surgeon White about one month in warm weather 1873 That he has been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 26 day of July 18 75 Tried to enlist again in army & was rejected

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the state of MD, and that his occupation has been that of a waiter

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a Porter

That he is now partly disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the service of pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation.
