I herewith transmit one original voucher upon which payment of pension was made in the claim of Amy Young, of #526 Tyson Street, Baltimore, Md., widow of Robert Young, late private, Co. B, 4th U. S. No. 321,195, for the period from March 4, 1895 to June 4, 1895; paid and canceled check issued thereon, #22,963 drawn June 8, 1895, upon the Assistant Treasurer of the United States at Baltimore, Md., by S. L. Willson, U.S. Pension Agent, to the order of the pensioner for \$24, and a communication under date of 16th ultimo from the pensioner relative thereto.
