who served during the late war
*in Co. B. 4 U.S. Inf.**In reply to your questions I*
will say that I have received
and realized on my pension
check every quarter.
Yes, I got my pension check for
the quarter ending June 4, 1895
endorsed it and got the money on it
My supposed complaint that I
never got my check for that quarter
is all the result of a mistake
There was some delay in my
getting my check for the quarter ending
Sept. 4, 1895 and I got my son
to write the letter dated Sept 16, 1895
and by mistake he put in
that I had not received my
June check when it was the
Sept check that I had not received
I had though since received
