ON THIS 14th day of April, 1889, personally appeared before me, a
Deputy Clerk of a Court of Record in and for the County and State aforesaid. Annie Young
(widow of Robert Young) a resident of 316 Eutaw Court in the County of
Baltimore and State of Maryland aged 38 years, who being
duly sworn, makes the following declaration, in order to obtain the Pension provided by the Act of Congress approved
July 14, 1862. That she is the widow of Robert Young who was
a private in Company (B) commanded by Chief Musician
in the 4th Regiment of United States Colored Troops in the War of 1861; that
her maiden name was Annie Robinson and that she was married
to said Robert Young on or about the 2nd day of September
1886, at 70 Moon alley Baltimore in the County of Baltimore
and State of Maryland by Rev. Robert F. Wayman and
that she knows of no record evidence of said marriage. I herewith files it as an exhibit
in this her case

SHE FURTHER DECLARES that said Robert Young (Principal Musician) her
husband, died at 414 Elbow Lane Baltimore City in the State of
Maryland on or about the 14th day of March, 1889
of a complication of diseases, heart disease & the effects of his wound to
his right leg a wound he received in the Army

She also declares that she has remained a widow ever since the death of
said Robert Young and that she has not in any manner been engaged
in, or aided or abetted, the rebellion in the United States; and she hereby appoints F. E. P. Brooke
219 Courtland Street Baltimore as her lawful Attorney, with
power of substitution, and authorizes him to present and prosecute this claim. The following the
name, date of birth, and place of residence of all the children of her deceased husband who were under
sixteen years of age at the time of his death

This claimant states that her husband had filed a claim for Pension for
wound to his right leg & this claim had been allowed but she cannot tell the number
of his claim as the papers have been perished & she deprived of them
