I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your request of Sept 15th, 1882, for certain information for use in the consideration of application for Pension No. 328.330 and to return it herewith, with the following information from the records of this office:

It appears from the Rolls of U. S. Colored Troops on file in this office that _____ was enrolled on the _____ day of _____, 186 _____, at _____, in Co. _____, Regiment of U. S. Colored _____, to serve _____ years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a _____ on the _____ day of _____, 186 _____, at _____, in Co. _____, Regiment of U. S. Colored _____, to serve _____ years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. _____ of that Regiment, for the months of _____, 186 _____, he is reported _____

The muster roll of Co. "C" 4th U. S. C. T. for Jan & Feb/65 reports private William A. Moore absent with remark "No record". On muster out roll of Co. dated Washington D.C. May 4th 1866 he is reported "deserted" Mch 1/65 from Ft Monroe Va. Regimental return for Jan/65 reports him absent, under head of "absent sick & wounded".

The following appears in the records of events on muster roll for Jan & Feb/65. June 4th this Co. joined the expedition under Gen Terry against Ft Fisher S.C. landed on Federal Point Jan. 13th. During attack on the Fort the Co was stationed behind line of fortifications, extending across the Point guarding rear of the attacking column. From Jan 15th to Feb 11th was engaged in building fortifications and doing picket duty. xxx The muster roll of Field & Staff 19th U. S. C. T. for Jan & Feb/65 reports Com. Sergt John H. Diggs absent sick since Sept 25th 1864.

The regiment was stationed at Chapin's farm Va Jan 1865.

Supposed to be the soldier inquired for as the name John Diggs is not borne on the rolls of Co. "B" 19th U. S. C. T. on file in this office.
