

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths, but if said officer has no seal, his official character must be certified to by a Clerk of a Court of Record.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

On this 20th day of October, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, James Benson, aged _____ years, a resident of Baltimore, county of Balto. State of Md.

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical James Benson who was enrolled on the 3rd day of March 1864 in "H" 19th U.S. (Here state rank, company and regiment in the Military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.) A Private

in the War of the Rebellion and served at least ninety days, and was Honorably Discharged at Baltimore Md on the 25th day of July 1865.

That he is been unable to earn a support by reason of disease of the (Partially or wholly) Stomach. Very Deaf in Both Ears (Here name the diseases or injuries from which disabled.)

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent.

That he has _____ applied for pension under application No. _____ That he is
