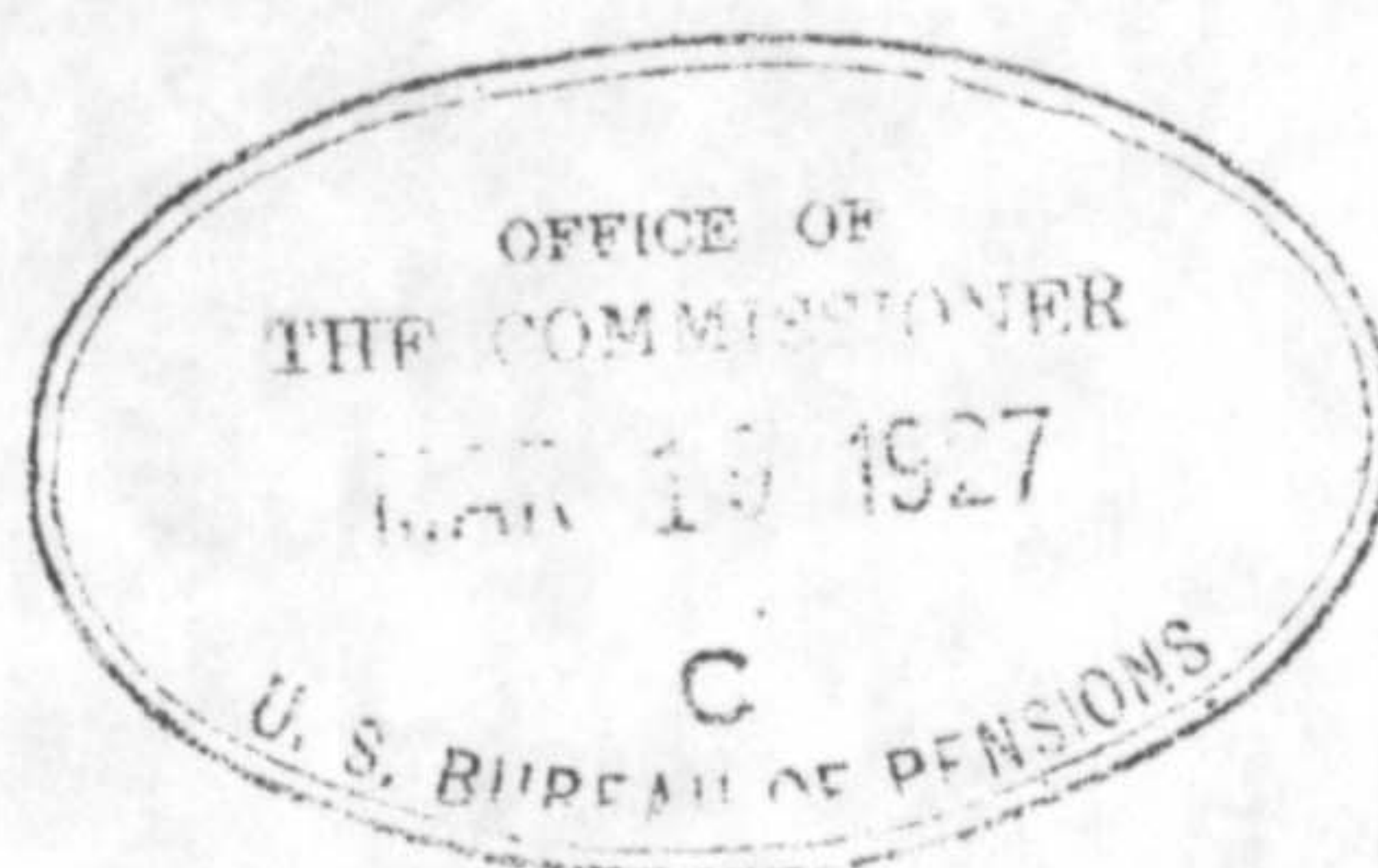
Dear Sir:
