Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 70; respiration, 18; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 3 inches; weight, 133 pounds; age, 47 years. General physical condition good.

Rheumatism: No crepitation or deformity of the joints.
Sensitiveness of muscles over both scapula and between the shoulders and also over the left side of the body. Has pains when using the arms, which he states is much worse in cloudy weather.
No evidence of rheumatism of the legs.
Heart, Lungs and Abdominal organs are normal.
Right inguinal hernia, complete, entering the upper portion of the scrotum. Tumor is three inches in diameter, reducible and can be retained by proper truss. External ring is patulous.
No evidence of neuralgia.
